AUDIO, VISUAL AND LIGHTING

- **Audio:** Audio equipment in our Sanctuary is the main vehicle through which we communicate truth during a weekend service. An audio equipment upgrade would eliminate harsh sound anomalies, aid in the effort to maintain a consistent sound presence no matter where you're sitting in the room, and further envelop the worshiper in quality sound during the worship service.
- **Visual:** Our projectors, screens and the technology necessary to run them allow us to communicate story, assist the pastor in communicating truth and the worshiper in worshipping. A visual upgrade would greatly improve our ability to share engaging content, improve screen visibility, and allow the use of screens while the room is more brightly lit.
- **Lighting:** We rely upon lighting in our Sanctuary to create an environment conducive to worship. A lighting upgrade would allow us to bathe our room in vibrant lighting and set the stage for engaging and intimate worship.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

- **Aesthetic:** From the beauty of the stained glass cross, to the material selections of flooring and paint, we desire to create a warm, welcoming and worshipful environment.
- **Function:** Updating the Sanctuary with acoustical fabrics, wood and stone will enhance the worship experience.
- **Community:** The Sanctuary is the one place where we all gather together. We are ready to remodel this space so that it becomes more conducive to welcoming newcomers as well as the next generation of believers.

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN FAQ

Why are we doing a capital campaign and what are the improvements/projects of the campaign?

With 30 years of use and only two minor improvements made during that time, our Sanctuary now needs to be brought up to 2018 technological standards and remodeled to reflect our values of being missional and invitational.

- To revive the Sanctuary with reconstruction and new AVL (audio visual lighting)
- To retire the mortgage debt so we are debt free, which will free up \$80,000 per year to use elsewhere

Construction Timeline: Prayerfully, summer 2019 (approximately June/July/August).
