Understanding Psalm 91

- Trusting in God's *faithfulness* is different than trusting in our desired outcome.
- Jewish Musar teachings – the Hebrew term for putting one's trust in God is *bitachon*.
- When we feel worry, anxiety, fear, or find ourselves clinging to something other than God, it's an *invitation to practice* trusting His faithfulness.
- Trusting makes us brave. When we realize God is with us regardless of the outcome, we find peace. We are also freer to act on our convictions, stop striving, take risks, etc.
- It's difficult (if not impossible) to make sense of suffering *in the moment*.
- Our challenges and tragedies bring growth *if we let Him*. It's our choice to grow, or build walls of anger or distrust in God.

HYMN HISTORY: In 1980, Michael Ledner composed "You Are My Hiding Place" at age 27 when he was going through a painful period of separation from his wife. He was living in a small, rented room in Tucson, Arizona where he wrote the song using his Bible, guitar, and painful feelings. He shared the song with several friends, made a recording of it, and set it aside. Nine months later he shared the song with a group in Israel. They took the song back with them to California, and after it was sung there, Michael was contacted by Maranatha! Music who wished to record it. Years later, he became a pastor and was married again.

SCRIPTURE THAT INSPIRED THE SONG:

- Psalm 32:7 - "You are my hiding place; you will protect me from trouble and surround me with songs of deliverance."
- Psalm 56:3 - "When I am afraid, I will trust in you."
- 2 Cor. 12:9-10 - "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.' Therefore, I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, I am strong."
