Covenants Throughout the Bible

Adam: The covenant of creation (or commencement)
 Noah: The covenant of preservation
 Abraham: The covenant of Promise
 Moses: The Covenant of Law
 David: The Covenant of the Kingdom
 Christ: The Covenant of Consummation
