Position Summary:

The Disability Discipleship Coordinator will lead the development, implementation, and management of the Disability Discipleship ministry. This person will lead and facilitate the inclusion of individuals with disabilities and their families in the community of the church. They will help increase awareness and advocacy for the larger disability community within our spheres of influence as we live out the gospel.

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Administrative:
 - Serve as liaison and coordinator between the families and church/ministry leaders and advocate for the needs of persons with disabilities in our congregation
 - Scheduling, budgeting, file management and administrative tasks in support of the above mission
 - Review, implement and follow all church and ministry policies and procedures
- Resource Coordination:
 - Connect families and the church with resources to aid in the mission of our Disability Ministry

- Training and Development:
 - Recruit, lead meetings, train, develop and oversee volunteer team
 - Strategize vision and share best practices with team/church and develop ways to overcome barriers to ensure each individual and their families can be fully immersed in the church community
 - Develop individualized spiritual care and support plans for persons with disabilities and create individualized profile/support materials as necessary
 - Develop training materials along with policies and procedures
- Other:
 - Other related duties as assigned by Director of Emerging Generations or other member of the Church leadership team
 - Support values of the organization through a focus on Competency, Character, Chemistry and Culture
